Case	Section of the Charter Being Challenged	Would this person's rights have been violated? Explain.
Jake Devereux is convicted of sneaking into the world famous Dorchester Fair so he is sentenced to a public flogging (whipping), followed by 25 years in prison where the only food is cold oatmeal.		
Visiting lovely downtown Dorchester on a nature walk, Tanya Gillis is arrested and taken to jail. When asked for the reason, the police officer refuses to tell Tanya anything.		
Alex Cortes starts up a club called the Dorchester Skate Board Club. Thames Centre council hears about this & enacts a civic by-law (town law) banning this new club from holding meetings.		
Loving the travelling life, Stephanie Klassen visits Quebec. She ends up in a French court on a charge of illegally hitch-hiking. Having slept through her French classes, she can only speak English and so she doesn't know what is happening.		
David Korman is charged with spray painting the "F-word" all over a parked car. At the trial, he learns that the owner of the defaced car is a judge who is actually going to sit as the judge of this very case.		
Constable Baltej Singh Dhillon , a Sikh, is fired for violating the RCMP dress code while performing his duties (wearing a turban and kept his beard).		
Jim Keegstra , a high school teacher, teaches his class that the Holocaust (the deaths of 6 million Jews in WW II) is a lie and that it never happened. He is fired for his actions.		
A group of aboriginals block access to a national park in protest of the federal government's breaking a land treaty in which the park occupied aboriginal land. The police arrest the group.		
Justine Blainey , a 14 year old girl, is a talented hockey player. The closest female team is over one hour away, so she tries to sign up for the boys' team in her town. The Ontario Hockey Association states in their constitution that only male players are to be members of a male team.		
A landlord tells 3 university students that he refuses to rent out an apartment to them because he has had trouble with students before.
