## **Research Component:**

On the Cornell-Note Sheets provided, each student will first begin by culminating 3-5 pages of notes from 5 different academic sources (these should be preapproved by the teacher).

The goal is to find:

- Examples of the original text and language
- The creator and origin story
- Summary of the main tenants or teachings
- List of terms specific to the teachings
- Popular critiques raised on the scriptures
- Social, Cultural and Political Importance
- The lingering effect of these scriptures on the world today

After completing the depth research component and collecting properly formatted quotations relating to each section, you will create a presentation.

## **Presentation Component**

The presentation must only include diagrams / charts / tables, brief points and properly cited quotations. It should also be formatted, so that the presentation runs by itself (this will be explained in class). Each presentation should be 10-15 minutes in length and include the vital information listed above and have a creative element
